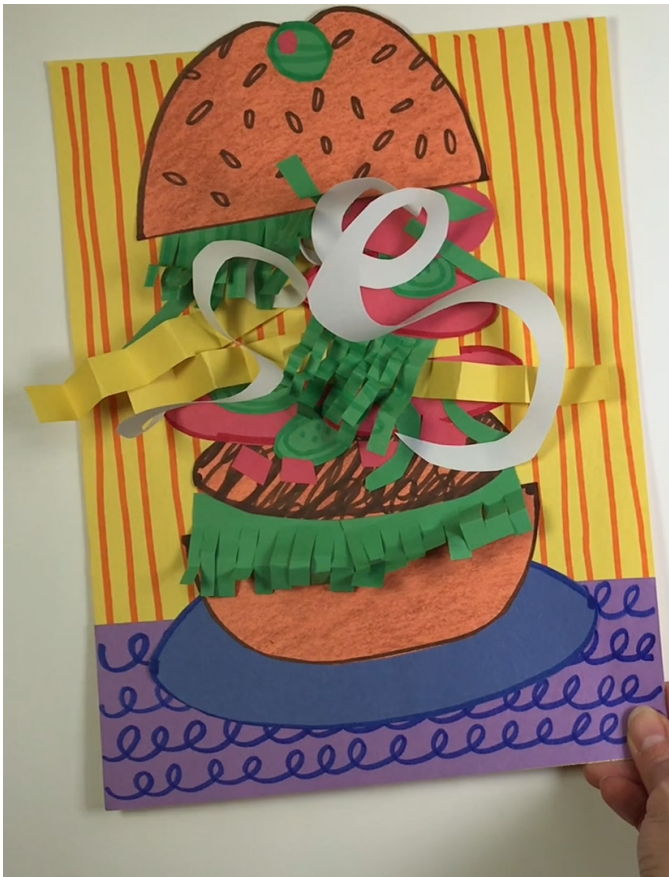




SANDWICH COLLAGE

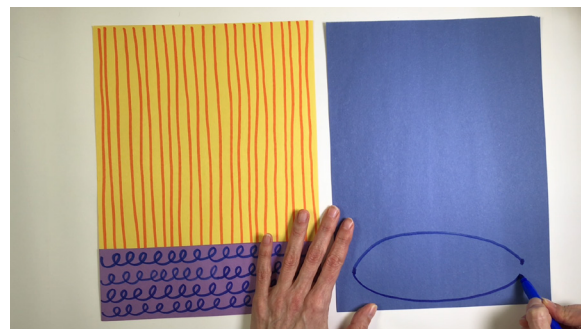
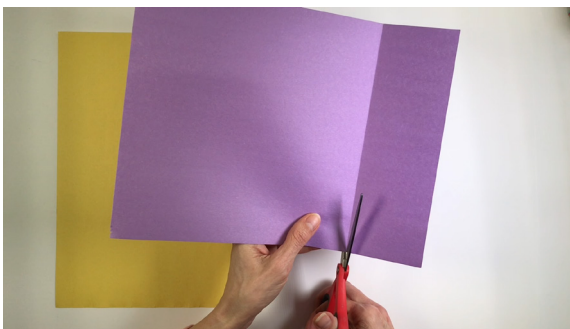

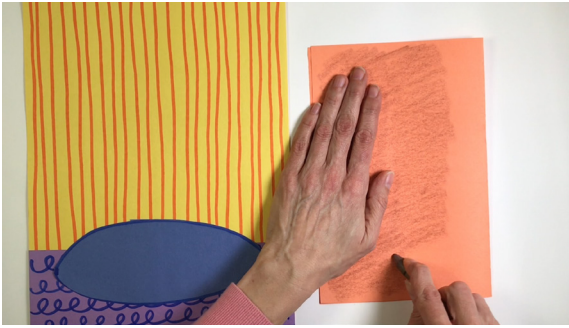
Materials:

- Prang® Medium Weight Construction Paper, 8 assorted colors, 9" x 12", 48 sheets, P104612-0001
- Prang® Disappearing Blue Washable Glue Stick, X15089
- Prang Classic Art Markers - Bullet Tip, 12 count, X80012
- Prang® Crayons, 24 count, X00400

Activity:

1. Remove some paper from the Prang medium weight construction paper pad. For best results, open the pad completely and tear each page out slowly.
2. First, select the colors you want to use for the background and table. To create the table, fold the paper to create a crease, then unfold and use the crease as a guide to cut table to size.
3. Decorate table and background papers with markers or crayon.
4. Glue table to background.
5. On another piece of construction paper, draw an oval shape for your plate. Cut out the plate and glue it on top of the table.





6. Create sandwich components with construction paper, using crayons and markers to trace shapes, create texture, and draw details.

7. Cut out each component. Feel free to add fringe (lettuce), spiral shapes (onion), and folds (shredded cheese) to create 3D effects.



8. Glue to your project, stacking them up on the plate paper as if you were creating a real sandwich.
